His name – *Trefoil*. •The year 1873. •The breeder *Mr S E Shirley* (founder of the Kennel Club in London) •The place of his birth – *Ireland*

In 2003 the AICSS reprinted with permission the research of the late Iris Combe (Tilehouse) and in 2007 independently produced, (for the International Collie Conference in Killarney), a presentation on this historical link between **Ireland** and the **Rough Collie**
